- Joslyn talked about a volunteering brochure being developed on the three catchment groups in Canberra, as a result of a media blitz over the next month. She will also attempt to have the winners of the Landcare awards placed in the Canberra Times. Social media avenues are being investigated and increased as well

- Purchasing and housing 2<sup>nd</sup> spray unit on hold.
- Have purchased smart phones with grant money for weed mapping and will work out details for loaning to groups and training in how to use them

- Ginninderra Catchment Group applied for grants for heritage walks with the Indigenous community
